#### Directive 2014/33/EU

Adopted by the European Parliament and the Council of EU on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2014

Published in the Official Journal on 29<sup>th</sup>

March 2014 (OJ L 96/251)

**Entry into force: 20th April 2014** 

**Implementation period: 2 years** 



Directive 95/16/EC is repealed with effect from

Directive 2014/33/EU shall apply from

20th April 2016



## **Task for the European Commission**

Shall submit a report to the EP and the Council regarding the implementation and functioning of this Directive before 19 April 2018

+ (if appropriate)

a proposal for revision of the Directive



#### **Main tasks for Member States**

1

- shall adopt and publish, by 19 April 2016, the national law necessary to comply with the provisions of the Directive 2014/33/EU
- shall apply this national law from 20 April 2016

- shall communicate to the Commission the text of the main provisions of national law which they adopt
- 3
- shall renotify all NB for the lifts before 20 April 2016

shall ensure that their NBs participate in the work of a Coordination Group of NBs for Lifts directly or by means of designated representatives



# Main tasks for notifying authorities

- shall organise and operate its activities in the way of the objectivity and impartiality
- •shall have a sufficient number of competent personnel at its disposal for the proper performance of its tasks

 shall inform the Commission of their procedures for the assessment and notification of conformity assessment bodies and the monitoring of NBs, and of any changes

- shall safeguard the confidentiality of the information it obtains
- shall be organised in such a way that each decision relating to notification of a conformity assessment body is taken by competent persons different from those who carried out the assessment



# Main tasks for Notified Bodies (1)

•Shall improve the quality of their competence

•Shall participate mandatory in coordination activities

- •Shall inform the notifying authority:
- any refusal, restriction, suspension or withdrawal of a certificate
- any circumstances affecting the scope of or conditions for notification
- any request for information which they have received from MSA regarding conformity assessment activities
- on request, conformity assessment activities performed within the scope of their notification and any other activity performed, including cross-border activities and subcontracting



# Main tasks for Notified Bodies (2)

 shall provide the other NBs with the information on issues relating to negative and, on request, positive conformity assessment results

 shall take full responsibility for the tasks performed by subcontractors or subsidiaries wherever these are established

shall participate in the standardisation work



## **Main tasks for Lifts industry**

Shall produce the safety components which shall satisfy the ESHR



Shall install the lifts which shall satisfy the ESHR
