Task for the European Commission

Shall submit **a report to the EP and the Council** regarding the implementation and functioning of this Directive before **19 April 2018**

+ (if appropriate)
a proposal for revision of the Directive

Main tasks for Member States

1

- shall adopt and publish, **by 19 April 2016**, the national law necessary to comply with the provisions of the Directive 2014/33/EU
- shall apply this national law from 20 April 2016

2

- shall communicate to the Commission the text of the main provisions of national law which they adopt

3

- shall renotify all NB for the lifts before **20 April 2016**

4

shall ensure that their NBs participate in the work of a Coordination Group of NBs for Lifts directly or by means of designated representatives

Main tasks for notifying authorities

1

- shall organise and operate its activities in the way of the objectivity and impartiality
- shall have a sufficient number of competent personnel at its disposal for the proper performance of its tasks

2

- shall inform the Commission of their procedures for the assessment and notification of conformity assessment bodies and the monitoring of NBs, and of any changes

3

- shall safeguard the confidentiality of the information it obtains
- shall be organised in such a way that each decision relating to notification of a conformity assessment body is taken by competent persons different from those who carried out the assessment

Main tasks for Notified Bodies (1)

1

- Shall improve the quality of their competence

2

- Shall participate mandatory in coordination activities

3

- Shall inform the notifying authority:
 - any refusal, restriction, suspension or withdrawal of a certificate
 - any circumstances affecting the scope of or conditions for notification
 - any request for information which they have received from MSA regarding conformity assessment activities
 - on request, conformity assessment activities performed within the scope of their notification and any other activity performed, including cross-border activities and subcontracting

Main tasks for Notified Bodies (2)

4

- shall provide the other NBs with the information on issues relating to negative and, on request, positive conformity assessment results

5

- shall take full responsibility for the tasks performed by subcontractors or subsidiaries wherever these are established

6

- shall participate in the standardisation work
